# **CHC43015 Certificate IV in Ageing Support**

# Enhance your skills and knowledge to take your career to the next level



This qualification prepares the student with the knowledge and skills to provide support to the Aged in both Care and the Community.

You will learn to support and facilitate the empowerment of older people, to provide support to people with dementia, to recognise healthy body systems, to support relationships with carers and families and to provide individualised support.

#### **Course Description**

This qualification reflects the role of support workers who complete specialised tasks and functions in the aged care sector. Workers will take responsibility for their own outputs within defined organisation guidelines and maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning and delivery.

Workers may be required to demonstrate leadership and have limited responsibility for the organisation and the quantity and quality of outputs of others within limited parameters.

#### **Course Delivery/Duration**

This qualification is delivered using a range of training and learning strategies. Students will attend face to face classes and participate in a range of methodologies including PowerPoint presentations, guest speakers, educator led practical sessions, group discussion and class room based practical activities including role-plays and simulations.

#### **Work Placement**

To successfully complete this qualification students are required to attend 150 hours of industry work placement. This will be arranged at an IRT or affiliated aged care site.
