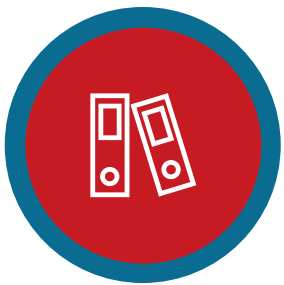

WHAT ARE THE STUDY REQUIREMENTS?

Students are required to complete online theory and project work, plus be assessed in the workplace. Course is self-directed, requiring students to have access to a computer with internet connectivity. This unit will takes about 15-20 hours to complete. Workplace assessment time is additional.

IS THERE WORKPLACEMENT?

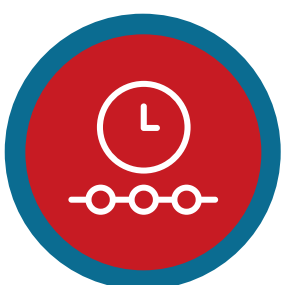
