WHAT ARE THE STUDY REQUIREMENTS?

Students are required to complete 2 online modules and related assessments. Course is self-directed, requiring students to have access to a computer with internet connectivity. Each module takes about 10 hours to complete. Workplace assessment time is additional.



IS THIS COURSE FOR YOU?

This skill set is for people working in various care and support roles in the community services industry who wish to develop skills in supporting people who require palliative care.



WHEN AND WHERE ARE THE COURSES HELD?

Complete this skill set via a blend of interactive online learning modules, simulation activities, as well as online and workplace assessments. Course is delivered twice a year - May and November intake.



IS THERE WORKPLACEMENT?

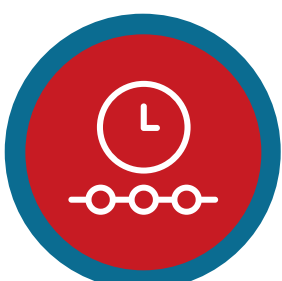
No formal workplacement hours are required, but there is workplace assessment. This is on-the-job observation completed by an accredited IRT Academy trainer and generally takes place at the person's place of work.

- Online-quiz
- Practical observations in the workplace
- Self-directed activities
